Prophecy, a hard rock band based out of Southern California, pays tribute to one of the best progressive/concept bands of the 80's, Queensryche.

Comprised of former members from groups such as New Eden, Akeldama, Engine 51, The Violent Breed, and Critical Mass, the members of Prophecy are well versed in genre of 80's/90's music.

Re-creating Queensryche's signature sound is no easy task, with dual guitar harmonies, multiple layers of backing vocals and keyboard tracks, accurate reproduction of Queensryche's studio sound in a live setting can be a very difficult task.

To meet this challenge, the members of Prophecy have spent more than a year in preparation, studying every aspect of Queensryche's music, techniques and writing style.

In an ongoing effort to reproduce Queensryche as accurately as possible, Prophecy devotes enormous amounts of time to analyzing all facets of Queensryche's sound from lead and backing vocals, to drum tones and more.

To emulate Queensryche's signature guitar sound, extensive research was done by Jeff McClure, Prophecy's Michael Wilton. Guitar tones were created from scratch and compared to both live and studio recordings across all albums, checking for consistency.



The mere mention of Geoff Tate's name sends many vocalists running for cover. Visions of a multi-octave range with amazing stamina and stage presence sends shivers down their collective spines.

At 6'5", Prophecy's frontman Tony Devita is a commanding presence. His ability to reproduce Geoff's range and style are unparalleled. From the very first note, Tony elicits a jaw dropping reaction from audiences everywhere.

As one half of the guitar team powering Queensryche, Michael Wilton's versatile playing and songwriting abilities contribute heavily to Queensryche's incredible sound.

Taking on the role of Michael Wilton, Jeff McClure masters Wilton's technique, phrasing and stage presence effortlessly. A supreme showman, Jeff always gives an energetic, over-the-top performance that must be seen to be believed.





As the second half of the songwriting team of Wilton/Degarmo, Chris Degarmo's killer chops are well known amongst guitar players. Degarmo wrote many of Queensryche's biggest hits, including Jet City Woman, Queen of the Reich and Silent Lucidity.

Being a fan of both Queensryche's music and Chris Degarmo's playing, Nick Laux eagerly took on the role of covering Degarmo in Prophecy.

No stranger to the 80's metal genre, Nick lives and breathes Degarmo on stage, always giving 110 percent at every show.

Much can be said about the thunderous percussion work of Prophecy. Hailing from Brazil, Fabricio Ravelli's rock solid timing honors Scott Rockenfield's great drum lines.



Heavily influenced by great drummers like Lars Ulrich, Scott Rockenfield, Eric Carr, Dave Lombardo, and Tim Alexander, Fabricio's flamboyant drumming style will thrill and please audiences near and far.



As perhaps the most overshadowed member of Queensryche, Eddie Jackson's rock solid bass playing is a presence definitely felt across all of Queensryche's albums. Assuming the role of Eddie Jackson, John Leighton thunders out Queensryche's bass lines with amazing precision.

John is a veteran of both original and tribute bands, performing with Wrathchild and The Violent Breed. John's excellent vocal work and commanding stage presence complete Prophecy's live sound.
